This month has seen the implementation of the Wiarnton Rotary Spring Colouring Contest. The aims of the contest were mostly achieved despite several impediments due to Covid 19 and the constantly changing regulations around same.

A collaboration among Wiarnton Rotary, Peninsula Shores District School, Foodland and the Salvation Army has resulted in a successful program for the children in Wiarnton. Eighty – one entries were received; winners in three categories were chosen and the prizes of new scooters were awarded.
