The Shore to Shore already has had 28 people register. Tom Hilditch, grandson of the race founder, will again be a major sponsor.

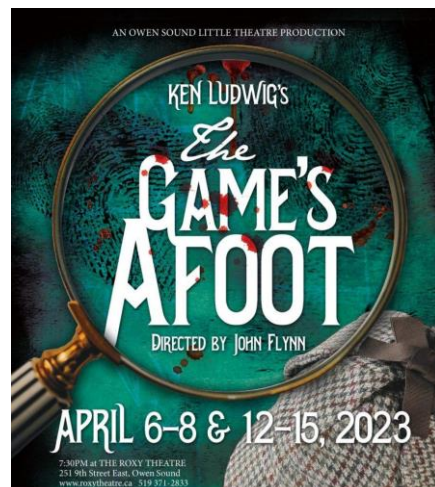
We have received a Thank You from Worship 2000, acknowledging the Club for our \$3000.00 donation.
