There are three separate funds with TRF.

- 1) PolioPlus accepts donations for the eradication of polio throughout the world. Donations are only invested for a short time as the funds will be used quickly.
- 2) Endowment Fund accepts contributions and invests them for the long term. The original amount is never spent. Only the interest that is earned is used for RI programs.
- 3) The Annual Fund contributions are invested for three years before being used for RI programs. Most of the interest generated during the three years is used to help fund TRF. Three years after the initial contribution, half of the original amount is returned to the District that generated the original donation and is referred to as District Designated Funds (DDF).

District 6330 uses their DDF for three programs at the local level:

- 1) District Grants: Half of the original amount is made available to help Clubs to do community projects they wish to initiate.
- 2) District 6330 has always provided \$15,000 annually to the Global Scholar program.
- 3) The balance is available to help finance Global Grants.
